Gender Pay Gap Report 2024

In accordance with the Equality Act 2010 (Gender Pay Gap Information) Regulation 2017, as an employer with over 250 employees Bordesley Multi Academy Trust (BMAT) is required to publish gender pay gap information for the snapshot date of 31 March 2024.

The overall gender pay gap is defined as the difference between the mean (average) or median (actual midpoint) hourly rate of pay of male and female employees. Under the Regulations the six measures that employers are required to report on are:

- mean gender pay gap in hourly pay
- mean bonus gender pay gap (if relevant)
- proportion of males and females in each bonus payment (if relevant)
- median gender pay gap in hourly pay
- median bonus gender pay gap (if relevant)
- proportion of males and females in each pay quartile

The results of these calculations for Bordesley Multi Academy Trust are:
