

# **ADMISSIONS APPEALS TIMETABLE (2020-21)**

(Amended 2/2/21 in line with revised DfE guidelines)

A new School Admission Appeals Code was published by the Department for Education on 1 February 2012. The Code came into force from 1 February 2012 and it applies to all appeals lodged on or after that date. The Code imposes a timetable for organising and hearing school admission appeals.

On the 1<sup>st</sup> of February 2021, due to the ongoing coronavirus outbreak, the Department of Education made temporary changes to the appeal regulations. Revised dates in line with the regulations are shown below.

### **In Year Entry Appeals**

Appeals resulting from in year admission applications will be heard as soon as is reasonably practicable of the appeal being lodged.

#### **September Entry**

Appeals resulting from applications for admission in September will be heard according to the following timetable:

Appeals lodged after these dates will be heard as soon as is reasonably practicable.

#### **Trinity High - Sixth Form**

Where the offer of a place would have been conditional upon exam results, appeals must be heard as soon as is reasonably practicable of confirmation of those results. Where the offer of a place would not have been conditional upon exam results, appeals must be heard as soon as is reasonably practicable of the deadline for lodging appeals.

## **Notification to Parents**

You will receive 14 calendar days' notice of the time and date of the appeal hearing. This can be waived if everyone agrees.

You will receive a statement a week before your appeal hearing outlining why your child has not been offered a place and why the school is unable to admit another pupil. Any additional documents you wish to submit in support of your appeal must be sent to the clerk within 3 days of the appeal hearing. Failure to do this may result in your appeal hearing being adjourned.
